

# How Does Cheap or Free Internet Sound?



## Emergency Broadband Benefit (EBB)

### WHAT IS IT?

The Emergency Broadband Benefit is a temporary FCC program to help households struggling to afford internet service during the pandemic.

### The benefit provides:

- Up to \$50 discount per month for broadband
- Up to \$75 discount per month for households on qualifying Tribal lands
- One-time discount up to \$100 for a laptop, desktop computer or tablet through a participating provider.

### WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

A household is eligible if one member of the household:

- Income at or below 135% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines or participates in certain government assistance programs;
- Receives free and reduced school lunch or breakfast program benefits
- Received a Federal Pell Grant during the current year;
- Experienced substantial loss of income due to job loss or furlough since February 29, 2020; or
- Meets the eligibility criteria for a participating provider's existing low-income or COVID-19 program.
