USDA has provided our department the flexibility to leverage our participation in one of their Summer Meal programs to provide meals at no cost to all ECISD students. Our dedicated School Nutrition employees will provide “Grab and Go” breakfast and lunch meals for our students. We will start on March 17th at 11:30 for lunch only. March 18th, we will begin providing both breakfast and lunch and will continue to provide meals as long as we have the staff and inventory to do so. In the event that we are forced to close down sites due to staffing, inventory shortages, minimal participation, or any other unforeseen circumstance, we will do our best to notify the public as soon as possible. Note: This program and these meals are for students only. Families can pick up meals for all children under the age of 18, or under the age of 21 for youth with special needs. Children must be present in order for meals to be provided. The meals will be provided at the main entrance of each participating campus. Parents are asked to remain in their vehicle when they pull up. We will deliver the meals to vehicles. (*Blackshear, Milam and Carver will all use Milam’s main entrance*)


