Review Community Resource Curriculum Chart

Nancy Vanley reviewed the District tab in this chart, which delineates the annual legally required lessons, what resources are available for each subject matter, and what “Needs”, if any the

district has for each subject matter. The current Needs include Parent Awareness in 1) Mental Health, Behavior Concerns, and Coping, 2) Substance Abuse, and 3) Suicide Prevention, Intervention & Postvention.

Additionally, the District needs 1) Elementary Curriculum for Cardiovascular Disease, Type II Diabetes, and Obesity and 2) K-12 Curriculum & Parent Awareness for Sex Trafficking (new requirement S.B.9).

Crystal Day and Hilberto Ochoa provided background on the health requirements; they are not mandated by the state for H.S. graduation. The District is proposing a Quaver Health Curriculum Toolbox at the Elementary level (K-5) which will provide teachers the resources to address Cardiovascular disease/Type II Diabetes/Obesity, and G-H Wilcox Curriculum that will be provided to campuses at the Jr. and High School levels to the address the same subject matter.

Dawn Weaks reminded SHAC that they previously considered recommending a Health requirement to the Board for adoption. SHAC supports the above-mentioned Health Curriculum, but there's a consensus that best case scenario would be to adopt a Health Requirement - no further action taken at this time for a health requirement.

Review Legal Requirements

- Parent Awareness: District has parental opt-in forms for each subject matter that is legally required. District needs to work on parent awareness/engagement of Mental Health, Substance Abuse & Suicide Prevention.
- District needs to meet cardiovascular, et al compliance at H.S. Level. Plan to do this via G-H Wilcox Curriculum.
- Legal Compliance: Teachers are required to certify that the required material has been presented.
- Sex Trafficking: Curriculum needs further research; need to determine which, if any community partners have compliant curriculum for K-12. Nancy Vanley, Dawn Weaks and Sarah Hinshaw to research further.

Motions Passed

- SHAC unanimously approved a motion to affirm/support the Human Health Curriculum that is being presented to the board for adoption - Quaver Health/PE for the Elementary Level and G-H Wilcox for the Secondary Level. The District will present and recommend the adoption of these two curriculums at the March Board Meeting. Sandra Mendoza made a motion to approve; Dawn Weaks seconded the motion.
- SHAC unanimously approved a motion to continue the current partnership between the District and the five non-profit community partners listed below, while being able to review and add other non-profit partners as needed to meet any additional legal or TEKS requirements. Dawn Weaks made a motion to approve; Sarah Hinshaw seconded the motion.
