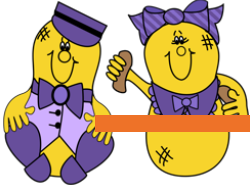

### **PARENTAL Engagement- POLICY 2022**

· Involve parents in the joint planning and development of the schools Title I plan through two different presentations in the Fall at our Milk and Bookies Family Night and Spring, through a survey sent home.

· Conduct an Annual Review each spring that will include an analysis of state and local assessment data, a review of needs and services provided, parent/teacher/and/or student survey data. This information will be provided during our Spring Academic Parent Teacher Team (APTT) Conferences.

· Involve parents in the development, implementation, and review of Parent-School Compacts. The compact will be discussed during our Milk and Bookies Family Night. The compact will also be posted on the district website posted in English, Spanish, or any other language requested by parents. Parents will be notified through notes home, SEESAW, Social Media, and School Status.

Our Campus Improvement Plan will be posted on the Carver Campus Website in English and Spanish. Parents will be notified of the posting once it has been approved by the ECISD School Board.

· Build the schools' and parents' capacity for parent involvement by:

- providing parents with information on state standards, CLI Assessment, requirements of Title I, monitoring their child's progress, and working with educators. Information will be provided during parent-teacher conferences, and on the district website. Notes will be sent home with students regarding this information during the 22-23 school year. Information will be posted and notes will be in English, Spanish, and any other language requested by parents.
- providing materials and resources to assist parents when working with their children to improve academic achievement during a variety of parent meetings, Social Media Platforms, SeeSaw, and School Status.
- communicating regularly with parents in clear and understandable terms.
- Parents will be contacted in a timely manner when they have a suggestion, concern or question.
- Parents will be kept informed of all school activities/programs via phone, newsletter, notes, marquee or email. Ex. APTT Meetings, Family Events, Curriculum Family Projects
- During parent-teacher conferences and/or other meetings, parents will be provided a description and explanation of the curriculum in use at the school, the school-parent compact as it addresses the importance of communication between school and home, types and forms of assessments used to measure students' progress, and the proficiency levels students are expected to meet. One conference will be held in the Fall (October) and Spring (April). Parents will have the opportunity to participate virtually or Face to Face. Each meeting will have two time options.
