In an effort to enjoy and celebrate Halloween at NTO appropriately, respectfully, and in accordance with school rules, we ask that students use the following guidelines when selecting a costume:

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1. **NO head coverings, NO masks, & NO face paint.**

Staff members must be able to identify students.



2. Costumes that are provocative, revealing, sexual in nature, or **employ props** are not permitted.



3. Costumes that depict violence, alcohol, or drugs are not permitted. Fake weapons are not allowed.



4. Costumes that could be offensive or perpetuate a stereotype of someone's culture, gender, heritage, or religion are not permitted.



5. Costumes should not hinder your ability to participate in your classes. Costumes may not disrupt or impede traffic, or present issues of safety in the hallways.



Students wearing questionable costumes will be asked to change into normal school attire. Masks are still required to abide by COVID-19 guidelines.
