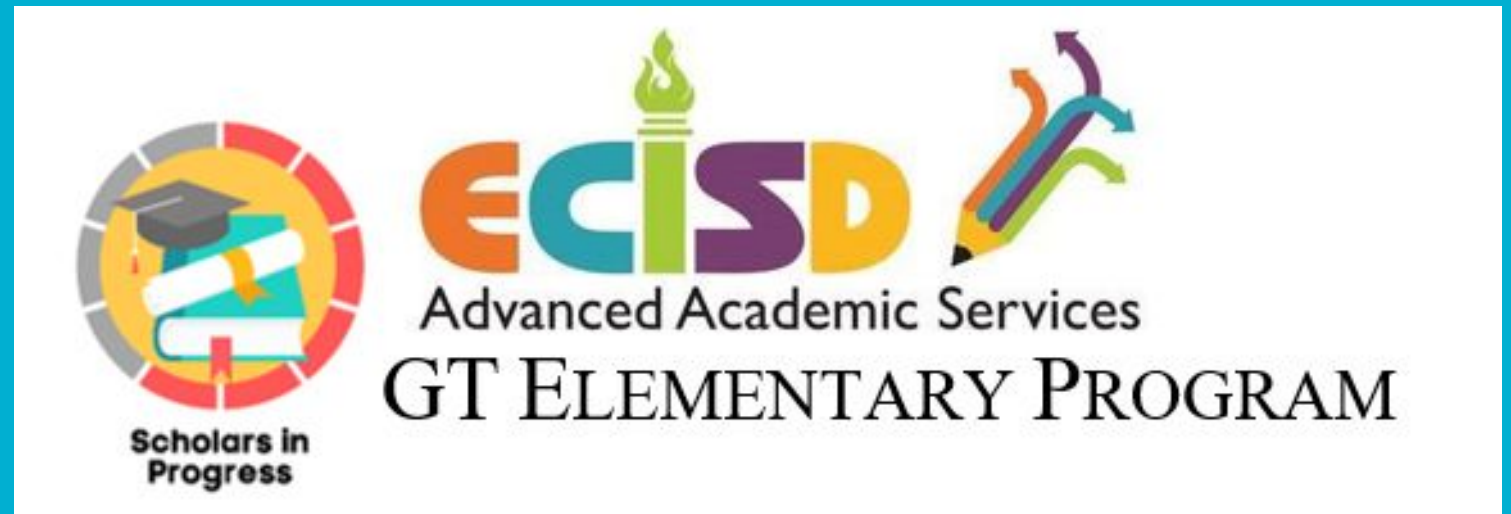

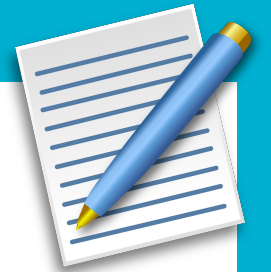

ABOUT THE GT PROGRAM

1st - 2nd grade students are served weekly by a GT specialist and in a cluster classroom with a GT trained teacher.

3rd - Elementary 6th grade students will participate in a pull-out program with a certified GT Program teacher for 120 minutes weekly for project-based learning and are also in a cluster classroom with a GT trained teacher.

Students will have the opportunity to think in deep and complex ways.

We want students to leave our 2 hours together with “pain in their brain.”

GT CLASS OPTIONS FOR BLENDED LEARNING: CHESS

- Chess is one of the options in the SIP classroom.
- Students have access to Chesskid. This online program is available for all students.
- In the spring, the SIP program will have a chess tournament for all GT students. The tournament will be **March 2, 2024** at Odessa High School. The chess tournament is an optional activity.
