



# 2022-2023 Required Registration for Ector County ISD

## Registration opens for New and Returning Students on **July 1st**

School attendance is mandatory under state law. Failure to enroll a student may result in truancy charges being filed against the parent (TEC 25.085).

### RETURNING Students

*Only parents or legal guardians may register a student*

#### Parent/guardian must complete the online registration process on a desktop/laptop/tablet

- (1) Create an Ascender Parent Portal account at <https://www.ectorcountysid.org/Page/2598> if you do not already have an account. Ascender email must match the parent email on record with the campus. Parent can verify their email by clicking the *Profile icon* at the top right corner and then selecting *My Account*.
- (2) Add your student(s) using their student portal ID. Student portal ID can be requested from the child's school.
- (3) Click the *Registration* button to verify contact information and upload the following documents **only if there are changes**:
  - (1) Driver's license or photo ID of parent/guardian registering student
  - (2) Proof of residency in ECISD (must be one of the following items):
    - Gas, electric or water bill indicating address of resident (must dated within last 30 days). A copy of payment is not acceptable proof of address.
    - Current lease agreement or mortgage statement
    - A driver's license is not acceptable proof of residency—it is only proof of identity
- (4) For incoming 7th grade students **ONLY**: Immunization record indicating they have received 2 vaccines: Meningococcal (MCV4) and Tdap

### NEW Students

*Only parents or legal guardians may register a student*

**Students who have never attended ECISD or returning ECISD students who did not attend during the 2021-22 school year.**

#### Parent/guardian must complete the online registration process on a desktop/laptop/tablet

- (1) Create an Ascender Parent Portal account at <https://www.ectorcountysid.org/Page/2598>.
- (2) The following items will be required to complete the online registration process:
  - (a) Student's social security card, birth certificate, and current immunization record
  - (b) Driver's license or photo ID of parent/guardian registering student
  - (c) Proof of residency in ECISD (must be one of the following items):
    - Gas, electric or water bill indicating address of resident (must dated within last 30 days). A copy of payment is not acceptable proof of address.
    - Current lease agreement or mortgage statement
    - A driver's license is not acceptable proof of residency—it is only proof of identity
- (3) Most recent report card, withdrawal form, and/or transcript from prior school is needed for proper grade placement.\*  
\*High school students will need to present a complete transcript showing all credits earned to assist in course placement.

The appropriate documentation must be obtained from the Office of Student Admissions before you can register a student outside of your attendance zone.

To enroll in Kindergarten for the 2022-23 school year, a student must be 5 years old on or before September 1, 2022.

Subject to the exceptions in Section 38.001(c), a student is required to be fully immunized against disease as required by the Texas Board of Health. (Section 38.001 (a), TEC) However, a student may be provisionally admitted if the student has begun the required immunizations and continues to receive the necessary immunizations as rapidly as medically feasible. (Section 38.001 (e), TEC) Students who are defined as homeless according to the federal McKinney-Vento Act, 42 U.S.C. §11434a, can be admitted provisionally for 30 days if acceptable evidence of vaccination is not available. The school shall promptly refer the student to appropriate public health programs to obtain the required vaccinations. A student who is a military dependent or any student transferring from another Texas school district may be enrolled for 30 days pending transfer of immunization records (25 T.A.C. 97.69). Except as provided by Section 38.001(c) or rule of the Health and Human Services Commissioner, a student who is not fully immunized and has not begun the required immunization may not attend school.
