

**UT Permian Basin Admission Process for Summer and Fall 2020
(03/31/2020)**

The University of Texas Permian Basin understands that the COVID-19 emergency has affected students' ability to access transcripts, take SAT/ACTs, and obtain important verification about GPAs. We want to ensure that students do not have any barriers to becoming a Falcon, so we have made some temporary changes to our admissions process:

- Expanded scholarship opportunities
- ACT and SAT tests are optional
- UTPB will accept self-reported GPAs for First-Year students
- UTPB will accept self-reported class rank for First-Year students
- No transcripts will be required for First-Year students to be admitted
- If as student has unofficial transcripts, they will be reviewed (not required)
- If a student has an unofficial mid-term grade report, it will be reviewed (not required)
- Unofficial transcripts are required for Transfer students
- First-Year students will receive a simple, one-page form from the UTPB enrollment team requesting self-reported academic information. This will also be available on the UT Permian Basin website
- Merit scholarships will be awarded based on self-reported GPA
- Official transcripts and SAT/ACT scores will continue to be evaluated if students are able to provide documents to the admissions office (not required)
- While official transcripts are not required in order to be admitted, when students officially enroll (attend classes), an official transcript will be required. We will work with students and school districts to obtain these
