- Host grade level math nights every quarter to preview math units and share strategies with parents

- Use application problems and other strategies to help children make real world/math concept connections
- Practice math facts with their child
- Attend parent workshops and math nights to learn tips and strategies to use at home (or access materials/resources online)

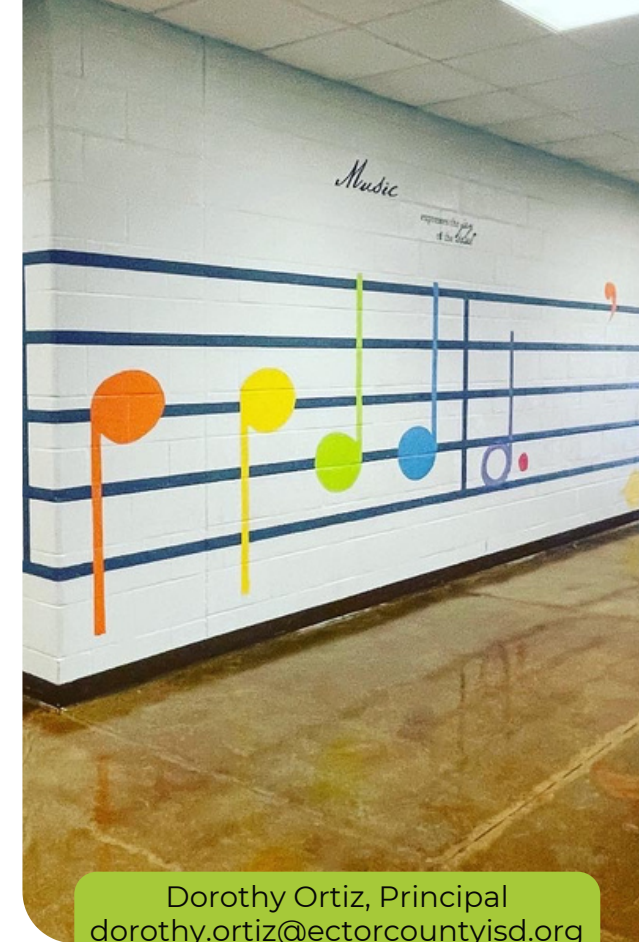

SCHOOL GOALS FOR ACHIEVEMENT

Through foundational excellence, talent development and the learning journey, we will improve rigor in our classrooms, and the percentage of students achieving or exceeding the meets standard on state assessments will increase from 86% to at or over 92% by May 2023.

Through foundational excellence, talent development and the learning journey, the percentage of 3rd grade students meeting or exceeding the standard on Composite - Reading and Math STAAR - will increase from 39% to 50% or above by May of 2023.

Through foundational excellence, talent development, and the learning journey, the percentage of Milam students prepared to promote to the next grade level will increase from 95% to 100% by May of 2023.

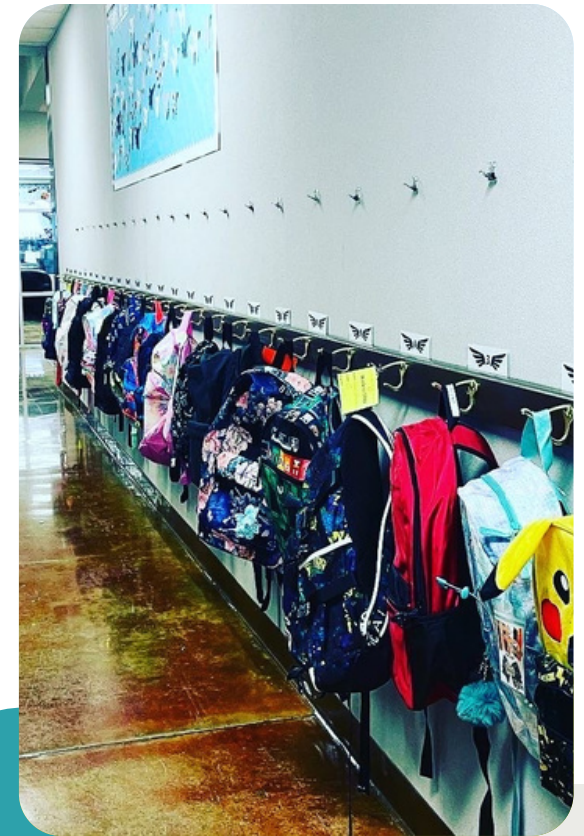


DISTRICT BOARD GOALS

Through foundational excellence, talent development and the learning journey, the percentage of students achieving or exceeding the meets standard on state assessments will increase from 32% to 60% by May 2024 across all tested content areas.

Through foundational excellence, talent development and the learning journey, the percentage of 3rd grade students reading at or above grade level will increase from 35% to 45% by May 2024.

Through foundational excellence, talent development and the learning journey, the percentage of high school graduates considered College, Career or Military Ready will increase from 56% to 65% by May 2024.

- Practice math facts for fluency (repetitive practice) using manipulatives or online resources

- Work to complete 2-5 Imagine Math Lessons Per Week
- Work to achieve Level 3 or higher on iStation
