Guidelines for high school football games this fall

As you are well aware, this is going to be a high school football season like no other before it. Ector County ISD officials are closely following the recommendations from the University Interscholastic League (UIL), Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), state and local health departments as it is preparing protocols for football game and other athletic contests. Here is a summary of the guidelines in place at this time, with the understanding adjustments may be made as necessary or as allowed.

Ticket Sales

In July, the ECISD Athletic Department announced its decision to not sell season tickets nor reserved seat tickets this year. General Admission game tickets will be available for purchase the week of each game **at the Ratliff Stadium ticket office.**

Current season ticket holders and parents of game participants (i.e., varsity football, band, spirit groups) may purchase tickets on Tuesday of game week. A maximum of four tickets may be purchased at \$8 per ticket during the hours of 7:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.

Remaining tickets will go on sale Wednesday of game week between 7:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. **at Ratliff Stadium ticket office** with the same maximum of four tickets at \$8 per ticket.

Any remaining tickets will be available at the Ratliff Stadium ticket office on the evening of the game.

Stadium capacity, restrictions

The UIL has directed: it is critical that schools are diligent in following the risk-mitigation guidelines. Schools are still required to follow Governor Abbott's Executive Order GA-29 related to face covering. Schools may allow spectators to attend contests up to a maximum of 50% of a venue's capacity, provided appropriate spacing as prescribed in the guidelines is maintained. All stadium spectators 10 years and older will be required to wear a face covering, that covers the nose and mouth, in the stadium unless they have a medical exemption.

For Ratliff Stadium, the 50% capacity limit combined with the required socially-distanced seating reduces available seating to about 30% (or approximately 3,000 seats) on the home side of the stadium. Seating on the

visitors' side of the stadium may be available depending on the crowd that comes from out of town. Stadium seating will be marked for social distancing, and groups will be placed 6-feet apart from each other.

All ticket purchasers will be required to pre-screen for COVID-19 before they enter the stadium.

Clear bags

In an effort to enhance security and more efficiently process spectator entry at the Ratliff Athletic Complex, ECISD Athletics has implemented a Clear Bag Policy. This policy regulates the size and type of bags that may be carried into the Ratliff Athletic Complex. This is in line with other large high school, college and professional venues across the state and nation. These requirements include Ratliff Stadium, Ratliff South Fields, Ratliff Softball Complex, and Ratliff Tennis Complex. Bags that are permitted include:

- Bags that are clear plastic and do not exceed 12" X 6" X 12"
- One-gallon clear plastic freezer bag storage bags
- Bags must be clear plastic, vinyl or PVC and have no more than one logo imprint not exceeding 4.5" tall X 3:4" wide
- Small clutch bags or purses do not have to be clear but cannot exceed 5" X 8"

Bags not permitted include:

- Backpacks, printed pattern plastic bags, fanny packs, purses, reusable grocery totes, mesh or straw bags, duffle bags, large totes, camera/*video bags* or binocular cases
- Diaper bags and medical bags, although not clear, may be allowed entry after inspection by an event administrator

Blankets will be allowed to be carried over the arm in cold weather. Propane heaters are not allowed in the stadium.

Broadcast and streaming of games

Due to limitations on the number of spectators able to attend game in person, the UIL has relaxed restrictions on live broadcasts and live streaming of football games for the 2020 season. Broncho and MOJO fans will have a number of ways to catch the games this year.

As is done each year, the games will be carried live by our radio partners, Texas Broadcast Industries. The schedule is to the left. The games will be broadcast on 97Gold FM (96.9 FM) and KICKS 99.1 (KHKX 99.1 FM) as well as streamed through the stations' websites.

Concession stands will be open and continue to be operated by the Downtown Lions Club in accordance with guidelines approved by the Ector County Health Department.

Custodial teams will clear restrooms and other high-touch surfaces throughout the games.

Players, band members, cheer squads, and spirit teams will not be required to wear masks while actively player or performing, however, they will be expected to wear masks when not playing or performing and they will be expected to maintain appropriate distancing whenever possible.

Press box and sideline passes

ECISD will continue to offer access to all local media outlets and visiting team media. Players' boxes on each sideline will be extended to the 10-yard line to allow for more distance between players, and that means space will be limited to just one representative from each media outlet allowed on the field during the game. The same one person per outlet limit will apply to the press box during the game. The one person per media outlet will be relaxed for pre-game or post-game live shots provided all face covering and distancing guidelines are maintained. Media members from outside our local market will not be accommodated at this time.
