Directions – Please read carefully: OCA will consider changing students’ mode of learning for the **FOURTH 9 WEEKS WHICH IS March 15 – May 27, 2021**. Due to guidelines set by Odessa College, no class can be more than 50% capacity. We will work with OCA families to accommodate their change of mode requests. However, the 50% capacity in each instructional classroom must be followed, which means each room has a cap in size. Not all families will have their requests approved, if we reach the 50% capacity limit. This is different than the plans for Odessa High, Permian High School, and New Tech Odessa. Fridays at OCA will still remain 100% virtual for all students.

If you are happy with your child’s current mode of learning, there is no need to submit this form. Your mode of learning will remain the same for the fourth 9 weeks as it was the third 9 weeks.
