

Computer application that allows downloading for offline reading (requires Adobe® Flash®)



User Options: Access the help menu, download Follett digital reader for Win/Mac or logout.



Read Aloud: Available for selected titles. Digital Reader text to speech feature.



Fit to Width: Resize page size to fit width of viewing pane.



Fit in Window: Resize page size to fit in window.



Page View: View a text as a single page or as a two-page spread.



Zoom: Increase or decrease the viewing/font size of the eBook.



Page Number: Displays the current page number. Enter a new page number to be taken directly to that page.



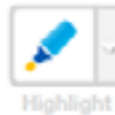
Page forward/backward: Navigate within the text by selecting the arrows to move forward or backward in the eBook.



Table of Contents: Displays the eBook table of contents and a list of user-bookmarked pages.



Search: Typing in a word or phrase will produce a highlighted list of where the terms may appear and links directly to the location in the text.



Highlight: Highlight important words or phrases in Yellow, Green or Pink.



Notes: Add notes, questions or comments to any page.

To access an additional set of features, highlight a portion of text and use the click the right button on your mouse (Control-Click for Mac):

Add Highlight with Note: Attach a note to a highlighted portion of text.

Add Highlight: Use the last selected color to highlight text.



Book Notes: View all notes and highlights.



Bookmark: Add and name a bookmark.



Titles Details: Provides user with access to title information.



Bookbag: eReader Bookbag enables a user to view all of the eBooks that they currently have checked out.

Check Out More Books: When connected to the internet, takes you to the FollettShelf.

Sync Checkouts: Sync checked out eBooks and any notes, highlights, or bookmarks that were added from Offline Use to Online Use.

Return Early: Return an eBook before its due date.

[Download](#)

Download: Take a book offline for reading when not connected to the internet.



Move Online: Move an eBook online to access from another device.

Mobile tablet application that allows online and offline reading (available through the Apple or Google Play App Store)

Once the APP is downloaded you will need your campuses "wbb#" from the Internet address in order to login to the app.

Note: some features are not available when eBook is downloaded.



Dictionary: Look up a word in the Merriam-Webster online dictionary.

Note: Individual words can be looked up by tapping to highlight the word on the page.



Notes: View all notes that you have added to the eBook.



Table of Contents: Navigate to a specific location in the eBook.



Search: Typing in a word or phrase will produce a highlighted list of where the terms may appear and links directly to the location in the text.



Book Bag: View or Download all checked out eBooks.



Download: Tap to download an eBook for offline reading.



Move Online: Move an eBook back online to enable notes, highlights and bookmarks.



Page View: View a text as a single page or as a two-page spread.



Zoom: Increase or decrease the viewing/font size of the eBook.



Page Number: Displays the current page number. Enter a new page number to be taken directly to that page.



Bookmark: Add and name a bookmark.



Check Out More Books: When connected to the internet, go directly to the FollettShelf to check out new books, return books already read or browse for interesting topics.



Logout: Logout of the Follett Digital Reader and the FollettShelf.



Note: To add a note, tap a location on the screen. When completed



Page Slider: Navigate forward or backward in the eBook. Click and drag the circle to navigate to a particular location in the eBook.
